Activity Sheet Instructions:

*Coloring Media simply refers to your choice of things to color the project with...crayons, marker, paint, etc. Play the music that goes with each activity sheet while working on the projects.

Card Stock is recommended for some projects for durability, but you may use regular white paper.

Reproducible 13-A – Thank You NOTE

Materials: Copy on White Card Stock/ Coloring Media/ Glue/ Jewels or Sequins/ Scissors/ Pens/ Envelopes

1. Color the Thank You Note with some interesting media from “Donna's Craft Corner Tips” pages. Try some glue on jewels or sequins.
2. Try coloring the letters in stripes, polka dots, plaids.
3. Cut out the card.
4. Fold it along the dotted line.
5. Ask the children to think of the people who they might send a thank you note to. (Consider the mailman, the janitor, the minister, their parents, their siblings...)
6. Have children write a note inside. If they can't write yet, let them draw a picture.
7. Have children fill out the envelope.
8. This could be a good group project to send a thank you as a class to the President, a sick friend, a person who has done a lot of nice things, the church's missionary, or minister.
